VENDOR INFORMATION
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2008**

Pumpkin Festival Vendor:

Thank you for your interest in the Davison Pumpkin Festival. The purpose of this information is to help us be better prepared for the festival.

Space numbers will be marked on the curb with chalk. Confirmation will take place Saturday morning, as someone will be there to direct you to your space.

Due to traffic congestion, please be sure you are entering at the proper end of town:

- Vendors in the **North Block** will be entering Main Street from Third Street and exiting Second Street to the **East only**.
- Vendors in the **South Block** will be entering Main Street from Mill Street and exiting Second Street to the **East only**.

All vendors need to be off the street at 7:30 a.m. and ready to receive customers at 8:00 a.m. **Under no circumstances will vehicles be allowed on Main Street after 7:30 a.m.**

The following is a list of items we recommend you bring for the entire day of the festival. We will do our best to accommodate all requests. Please remember that we will determine your location by your power requirements.

ITEMS TO BRING:

1. Warm Clothing!!!
2. Tables and extra chairs (**no tables or chairs will be provided**)
3. Money for pay phones
4. Table coverings
5. Paper toweling
6. Legible sign with club name, food and prices
7. For display- business cards, club brochures, photos, etc.
8. Name tags for table attendants

9. Cover for rain or snow (Spaces will accommodate tents 10x10, must be self standing with anchor weights. For Safety of Visitors – ropes and stakes are not permitted.)
10. Umbrellas
11. Any health department requirements
12. Start up cash, adequate for the entire day.

We discourage vendors from leaving the festival early, as it causes disruption. Please plan a 6:30 p.m. closing.

You are required to clean up your area following the festival Saturday evening. Please bring the proper equipment (gloves, brooms, rakes, trash bags, etc.)
